



MEMBERSHIP POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Stone Creek Golf Club (SCGC)

SCGC policies and procedures are in place to allow us to better serve you and to provide an enjoyable, rewarding experience for all. By accessing our facility, you consent to have read, understood and agree with all terms in CFC's membership policies and procedures.

General Policies:

1. All members and guests are required to sign in at the gate.
2. All members must have their picture taken for their membership account.
3. Members must be current on their dues to be considered a member in good standing and gain entrance into the facility.
4. Members are asked to please observe facility closing times and be prepared to leave promptly at that time.
5. CFC will make every attempt to remain open in inclement weather, however, we reserve the right to delay opening, close early, or remain closed if the weather is serious enough to put staff and members at risk. Furthermore, memberships will not be refunded or prorated due to such event.
6. Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
7. Membership rates are subject to change.
8. Memberships will not be refunded, prorated, or extended due to lack of usage, travel, or failure to provide proper documentation according to membership holds and cancellation policies.
9. Members and guests under 16 years old must be accompanied into the Pool Area by an adult at least 18 years old.
10. Food and drinks are allowed in designated areas only.
11. SCGC is not responsible for personal property lost, damaged, or stolen while members and/or guests are using the facilities or participating in a program.
12. Video recorders, cameras or any other visual recording devices are not allowed within the facility without the express written consent of the Executive Director or other management staff. Anyone caught taking pictures of another person without their permission and knowledge will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law by SCGC and will lead to termination of membership.
13. Improper sexual behavior will not be tolerated. Membership will be terminated.
14. For your well-being, NO SMOKING or use of tobacco products of any type is allowed in the building or pool.
15. No pets allowed at pool. Service animals trained to aid a person with a disability are welcome.
16. Action, activities or language that is disrespectful to others or abusive will not be tolerated. Youth and Adults unmindful of others will be counseled and appropriate action taken.
17. Pool attendants shall have the authority to enforce all rules and regulations and to supervise the general conduct of all persons in the pool area. Pool attendants shall have full authority to maintain order, reprimand, discipline, restrict and evict any individual not complying with the rules and regulations.
18. Running, wrestling, pushing, dunking and excessive noise or other hazardous activity will not be permitted in the pool or pool area.
19. No glass containers of any kind will be permitted within the pool enclosure.
20. Lifesaving and pool cleaning equipment should be used only for the purpose intended.
21. Please do not unnecessarily talk to or distract the pool attendant(s) on duty.
22. Swimmers are not allowed in any part of the Clubhouse in their swim attire. Swimmers must be dry and wear a cover-up or must be fully clothed when entering the Clubhouse.
23. Members and their guests are responsible for properly disposing of their trash in the pool area.

Illness and/or Medical Conditions:

- 1) Persons are not permitted in the pool if they have a cold, cough, fever, infection of any kind, skin rash, inflamed eye(s), or are wearing bandages.
- 2) Persons with physical or neurological disabilities or a responsible adult accompanying that person must advise the pool attendant of such conditions.

Pool Attire

- 1) Persons must wear suitable bathing attire while swimming; no cutoffs, dungarees or Bermuda shorts will be permitted.
- 2) No material that is weathered or torn that may cause pool filter to clog.
- 3) Management reserves the right to not allow entrance to pool area if anyone is considered to be dressed inappropriately.
- 4) Outside of pool area, members are to wear cover up and shoes in Clubhouse.
